Title:

The Future of Archaeology in the Universities.

Abstract:

Several countries are now well advanced in adopting the structure for university degrees as recommended under the Bologna Agreement, but the implications of what is happening go well beyond a simple change of structure, and will affect the shape, size and role of university departments and their relationship with the whole profession of archaeology in Europe, if not the world. In this session we will be looking at the implications, drawing on the experiences of those countries which have already made the change, those that have just started the process, and where this may lead to, how it relates to topics such as professional qualifications, movement of people across national frontiers, and the content and purpose of archaeology degrees.
